 - iii) Have completed contracts with a total cumulative value equal to at least USD 80,000.00 in the preceding 2 years.
 - iv) Not be under any notice of suspension or disbarment issued by the Government.
5. Quotations must be delivered to the address given below at or **before 10:00AM, 16th November 2021**. Late Quotations will be rejected. Quotations will be opened in public immediately thereafter at the address given below in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend.
6. The Purchaser shall award the Contract to the Bidder whose offer has been determined to be the lowest evaluated quotation and is substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents, provided further that the Bidder is determined to be qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.
